

Questions for Reading

Definition – Deeper understanding of specific characters and character traits

- Who are the characters?
- Can you describe them?

Comparison – Find similarities and differences between characters, books, or between a book and life experiences.

Relationship – How do characters, setting, plot and conflict affect one another?

Circumstance – What is going on in the rest of the world at the time the book was written or in the time in which it was set?

- Your child may not have the answer yet, but as they learn more about the world, they will begin to ask these questions on their own and answer them.

Testimony – Think about other ways to advance their arguments.

- Should this work of fiction be considered a valid testimony?
- Is there truth in fiction?
